B: Inscription in five lines: σε|φορο|ααπ|οπαντο|σκακου → [φύλασ]σε [τὸν] φορο[ῶντ]α ἀπὸ παντὸς κακοῦ.

'Protect the wearer (of this amulet) from all evil.'
