Inscription around the figure:  $\theta\alpha\rho\upsilon\chi\omicron\upsilon\nu\omega$  (above),  $\beta\alpha\lambda\beta\alpha\nu\eta\chi\ \lambda\alpha\epsilon\nu\nu\omicron\rho\alpha$  (below) → voces, unidentified.
