A: Winged Pantheos figure, to front, feet to right. The figure wears a kilt, his head is covered with a headdress and topped with a crown or the solar disk. Right arm lowered beside the body and holding the hieroglyph 'sa', the raised left hand supports a was-scepter.

B: Inscription in seven lines: $\chi\omega\sigma\alpha|\mu\epsilon\iota\lambda\omega|\kappa\epsilon\chi\omega\kappa\omega|\pi\lambda\omega\chi\theta\upsilon|\pi\alpha\omega\chi\omicron||\lambda\omicron\zeta\lambda\alpha|\zeta\alpha\rho\mu\epsilon$ → voces. (For a gem with a similar inscription, see below Bonner, SMA.)
