A: Ithyphallic baboon, to front. Both arms raised and bent in elbow, with an eight-pointed star above the right hand, and a nine-pointed star above the left hand. Head turned right, on top of it an uraeus with a palm branch in its jaws. In the free field on the right: lion-headed Chnoubis, to left, with seven rays around the head. On the left: Chnoubis-sign and inscription running from top to bottom: χνουμισ → Χνουμίσ.

B: Inscription in three lines: ηλιαν|βρωαβραμωθ|ανοχ → ηλιαμβρω, variant of αβραμωθ, Ἄνοχ. Post-antique?
