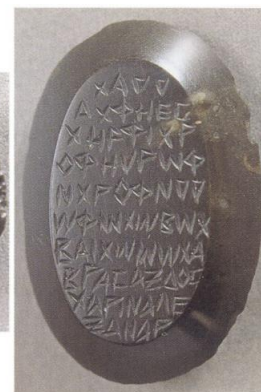


Magical gem: Harpocrates, baboon, a jackal-headed figure and two falcons in papyrus boat (A) Voces, δὸς χάρις (B)

A: Harpocrates sitting with one leg bent in knee on a lotus flower with two buds, which is situated in a papyrus boat with falcon-heads. Harpocrates is crowned with the solar disk and six rays, right hand raised in greeting, left hand holding a flail. On the left, facing him, the standing figure of jackal-headed Anubis in kilt, left hand holding a sceptre; on the right, behind him, an ithyphallic baboon with paws raised in greeting and crowned with the solar disk. Crowned falcons perch on the prow and stern of the boat. To the left of the head of Harpocrates, a crescent, to the right, an eight-pointed star.

B: Inscribed in ten lines:

χαυρ|δχφηεσ|χηρφυχρ|οφηρυρωφ|υχροφνυυ||ωφωχωβωχ|βαιχωωωχα|βρασασξδοσ|χαριναλε| ξανδρ → variant of χαβραχ-logos, variant of Βαῖνχωωωχ, variant of Ἀβρασάξ, δὸς χάρις Ἀλεξάνδρ<ω> or <α>?
