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A: Isis seated in profile to right on a throne. She is wearing a tunic and a mantle, on her head a solar disk with cow's horns. She is nursing the Apis-bull, facing her.

B: Male figure (Ptah/Hephaistos?) standing to front, head to right, wearing a tunic and a cap, over his head a solar disk. In his right hand a scepter, in his left hand pincers.
