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A: In the centre, nude Harpocrates standing to front, head to right, crowned with the double crown. Left hand raised to mouth, right hand holding a cornucopia and his mantle. The figure of Harpocrates is framed by the busts of Sarapis and Isis, facing each other. The head of Sarapis is surmounted by a calathus, Isis is crowned with the Isis-crown. The shoulders of both deities are draped.
