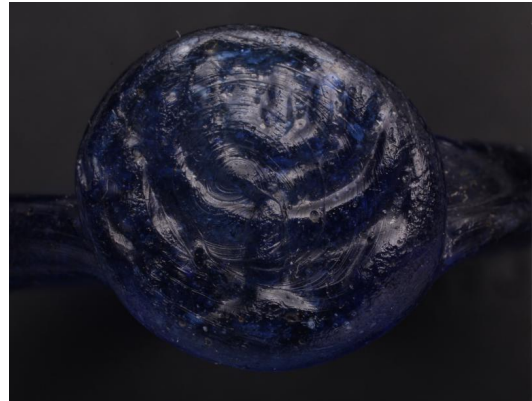


## Amulet(?) ring: Menorah
