A: Frontal view of a cock-headed Anguipes in armour, head to right. Whip held high in his right hand, shield in his left hand. The two notches inside the shield are perhaps indications of the porpax and the antilabe. Above the figure, an eight-pointed star and a crescent open to top, two more stars to the right. Greek inscription in the free field around the figure: $\omega \nu \mu |\alpha \beta \lambda \alpha \nu| \alpha \omega \rightarrow \omega$ unidentified vox, variant of $\lambda \beta \lambda \alpha \nu \alpha \theta \alpha \nu \alpha \lambda \beta \alpha$ -palindrome?, $\lambda \omega$
