A: Jackal-headed Anubis in kilt, standing to right, right hand holding a dagger(?), left hand holding a scepter. Inscription around the figure, beginning at bottom left: ἀνοχαρριαμιστιμιοβιουβαλβηλ → voces including Ἄνοχ, variant of Βήλ.

B: The bust of Helios with seven rays around the head. Inscribed below the bust: λκτλ.

C: Inscription around the edge: ἀνοχαρβιαψυχναετβντκαιφρεα → voces including Ἄνοχ.
