**Description:** Upright oval, both faces flat. Form 8-9. Haematite. The lower left part broken off and missing.

**A:** Rider on horseback to left, wearing tunic and mantle, right hand lowered and holding a spear (?). An eight-pointed star near the head.

**B:** Greek inscription in three remaining lines:  $\nu\iota?[\text{---}]\omega[\text{---}]\upsilon\sigma\sigma?[\text{---}]$  → unidentified voces.
