**Description:** Upright oval, both faces flat. Shape 8-9. Haematite. Intact.

**A:** Two figures facing each other. On the left, a male figure (Hermes?) wearing tunic and boots, and holding two stalks of wheat in his right hand and a bird-headed scepter in his left hand. On the right, jackal-headed Anubis, wearing a kilt, left hand holding a torch, right hand holding scales (?). Greek inscription above the figures:  $\varphi \epsilon \rho \omega$ , between them:  $\iota \alpha \omega \to I \dot{\alpha} \omega$ , below the baseline:  $\varphi \sigma \rho \epsilon \nu \to I \dot{\alpha} \omega \varphi \{\sigma\} < \dot{\epsilon} > \rho' \, \dot{\epsilon} \nu \, \psi \, \dot{\epsilon} \rho \omega$ . 'I\(\darka \omega \text{fetch one, I am fetching it.' (Translation based on \(\frac{CBd-2191}{CBd-2191}.)\) **B:** Three lines of characteres including planetary and zodiacal symbols (Taurus, Saturnus, Sagittarius, Sol and Leo).

The gem may have been carved after a drawing in <u>Chifletius–Macarius</u>, <u>Abrasax</u>, see <u>CBd-2819</u>. For a similar gem in the Kunsthistoriches Museum in Vienna, see <u>CBd-2191</u>.
