A: Male figure (Sarapis?) wearing a modius, a tunic and boots, holding a wreath in his left hand and a cornucopia in his right hand, with a mantle hanging from his right arm. Greek inscription on the right and left side (ν 's in mirror writing): $\epsilon\lambda\epsilon\nu|\beta\omicron\nu$ → unidentified vox.
