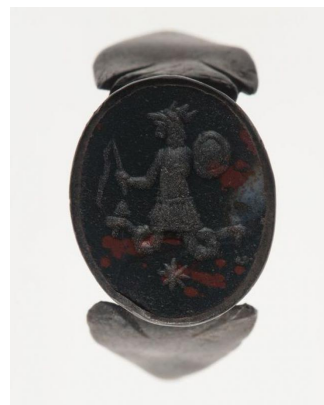


Magical gem in an ancient silver ring: Anguipes
