**A:** Lion-headed Chnoubis in profile to left, with seven rays around the head. Inscription around, beginning at the bottom: γιγαντοπαντορηκταβαροφονταβαρουφειτα → γιγαντοπαντορήκτα βαροφοντα βαροφίτα. 'Breaker of all the giants, crusher of snakes.'

**B:** Chnoubis-sign, below: χνουβι → Χνουβίς.
