**A:** Ouroboros enclosing a uterus in the form of a cupping vessel with a six-bitted key below and mumiform Anubis with a lion-headed Chnoubis and a deity wearing a tunic with a modius above the uterus. Below: naked donkey-headed, sitting figure. Greek inscription along the edge: ζ σοροορ μερφ...ργα.μαθρι.γ → part of the σοροορ-logos.

**B:** Greek inscription in two lines: ορωριουθ.
