A: Frontal view of cock-headed Anguipes, head to right. The god is in armour, right arm raised high and holding a whip, left arm not indicated. On the left: large round shield enclosing characteres or letters. Inscription below the legs: $\iota\alpha\omega$ → Ἰάω.

B: Inscription in eight lines: $\iota\alpha\eta\iota\iota\eta\theta\upsilon\sigma\upsilon\chi\eta\eta\eta\omega\alpha\kappa\rho\alpha\mu\mu\alpha\chi\alpha\mu\alpha\beta\epsilon\iota\mu\alpha\rho\upsilon\theta\epsilon\alpha$. On the left edge from bottom to top: $\beta\rho\alpha\mu\zeta\epsilon$ → voces including vocales, variant of Ἀκραμμαχαμαρεί, variant of Μαρμαραουώθ.
