A: Remains of an Anguipes: only the snake's legs have survived, below the legs: an eight-pointed star. Around, fragment of an inscription beginning on the top right: ναισαβαωθιαωι → [Ἄδω]ναί, Σαβαώθ, variant of Ἰάω.

B: Inscription in two lines: η|κκιξ?| → unidentified voces.
