Inscription in two lines in the free field to the left of Chnoubis: χνουβίσ → Χνουβίς. To the right of Chnoubis: ἄνοχ → Άνοχ. In the third line: σεμειλαμψ → variant of σεμεσειλαμ, with a stroke of division instead of the second sigma.

B: Characteres and letters in five lines: ζ|ζ|three eight-pointed stars|οοιοσ (σ: in mirror writing)
