A: Circle enclosing a human figure (on the right), to front, head in profile to left, right hand raised and stretched out, left hand resting on a staff (Moses?). Facing him, a large, rearing snake (on the left), its head damaged by the hole bored through the stone. Behind the snake, a diamond-patterned semi-circle. In the free field on the right, from top to bottom:  $\iota\alpha\omega \rightarrow \text{Ἰάω}$ . Below the figure:  $\chi\rho\iota \rightarrow \text{Χ(ρ)ι(σ)τός}$ .

B: Inscription in seven lines:

$\iota\alpha[.]|μ\iota\chi\alpha|ο\upsilon\rho\iota\eta[.]|ο\upsilon\theta\rho\iota\eta[.]|γ\alpha\beta\rho\iota\eta\lambda||\chi\epsilon\rho\upsilon\beta\iota\mu \rightarrow \text{Ἰά[ω], Μιχα[ήλ], Οὐριή[λ], Οὐθριή[λ], Γαβριήλ, Χερουβί[υ]}<\mu>$ .
