A: In the middle of the gem two concentric circles (Ouroboroi), with rays on the left and the right side. Inside, inscription in six lines: χουθυ|λαιλαμ|θαλθαλ|ψυθαλθο|ροσι||ιω → voces including Λαῖλαμ. Outside, on the left: πυροσοχ[- -]|κρηφο|σουμαρτα|αρφου|ουθερ||φουθ. Outside, on the right: ανοχ|μουι|ωρω|υαλαλ → voces including variant of σουμαρτα, Ἄνοχ, variant of Σερφουθ Μουι Σρω. Under the Ouroboroi: λυσοιθιδαβυθω[- -] συπνειψια → unidentified voces.

B: Characteres.

C: αβλανα[- -]ινα[- -]αν → variant of Ἄβλαναθαναλβα.
